

## Truth, Reconciliation & Equity: They Maffer to Us!

## KAIROS EDUCATION FOR ACTION FOCUS

In 2008, the Government of Canada apologized to former students of Indian Residential Schools for the abuses that they endured and from which generations continue to suffer. In 2010, the first national event of the Truth and Reconciliation Commission was held in Winnipeg, and, after years of stalling, Canada quietly announced its endorsement of the *United Nations Declaration on the Rights of Indigenous Peoples*. Together, these moments should mark a turning point in the lives of Indigenous peoples in Canada.


In June 2011, thousands of people from all walks of life created more than 300 handmade banners stating their commitment to the *Declaration*. Joined together to form one huge banner, they were carried through the streets of Ottawa as a country's witness to its government: Make this endorsement real. Deal with current inequities. Make the *UN Declaration* a path to a better future—a sign that Canada's 2008 apology really meant something.

First Nations, Inuit and Métis peoples in Canada continue to face serious injustices. Together we can do better, and we can make a difference.

KAIROS continues to support the Truth and Reconciliation Commission (TRC) by raising awareness of its work and supporting non-Indigenous people to hear the truth by attending hearings and events. We are committed to seeing the *UN Declaration on the Rights of Indigenous Peoples* put into action. And we want to work with **you**.

For the mistakes of the past, Canadians need to **hear and tell the truth**. With the promise of **reconciliation**, Canadians need to **end the inequities** of the present. Join KAIROS as we work together towards right relationship and equity between Indigenous peoples and non-Indigenous Canadians. 
