Government of Canada will remove pre-entry test requirement for fully vaccinated travellers on April 1

The purpose of this email is to inform you of an <u>announcement</u> made today (March 17, 2022) regarding the easing of testing measures at the border for fully vaccinated travellers seeking to enter Canada, including Temporary Foreign Workers.

Please be advised that, *effective April 1, 2022, at 12:01 AM EDT*, fully vaccinated travellers will no longer need to provide a pre-entry COVID-19 test result to enter Canada by air, land or water. Fully vaccinated travellers seeking to arrive in Canada before April 1, 2022, must still have a valid pre-entry test.

The Temporary Foreign Worker Program will continue to keep you apprised of any new information as we receive it, and invite you to visit the travel.gc.ca for further details and updates.
